

## **Dallas Police seeking the assistance of the public for 58 yr old missing man**

**DALLAS** -- Dallas police were looking for a missing man Sunday, NBC 5 reported.

Richard Garza, 58, was last seen Saturday morning walking from his home in south Oak Cliff wearing a blue button-down shirt with white stripes, and tan shorts, authorities said.

Police said Garza, who is legally blind in one eye and has diabetes and schizophrenia, was wearing a medical ID necklace.

**OAK CLIFF** — Dallas Police Missing Persons Detectives are seeking the assistance of the public in locating Richard Garza of Dallas. Mr. Garza is 58 years old, H/M 5'05"/160 lbs. with black hair. On Saturday, September 8, 2007, Mr. Garza left home around 11:00 am, walking in an unknown direction from his residence at 714 S Oak Cliff St. Mr. Garza suffers from diabetes, schizophrenia and is legally blind in one eye. Mr. Garza was last seen wearing a blue button down shirt with white stripes and tan shorts. Mr. Garza is wearing a medical ID necklace. This incident was reported on service number #650210T.
