I wanted to take just a minute to thank you for all that you have done for our family. From the time that I saw the United Response Search and Rescue Team on Fox 4, December 4th searching for Shirley Geanes, I knew you all were special. At that particular time, I just did not realize how special. I emailed you that night after watching the news. When you emailed right back, I was truly amazed as for the past (9) nine months previous, our family had just been running into brick walls. It seemed like no one, including law enforcement would help. After just (30) thirty minutes of talking to you on the phone on December 5th, my daughter and I met you. Then, you drove with us from Midlothian to the field located in Dallas to survey the property. It was bitterly cold and wet, but you all surveyed the field for several hours. A search was set for that next Sunday, December 12th (Jimmy's birthday) at 8:00 a.m. This was Russell's first search alone as Sheila and Dana were already committed to a search in Lubbock. He came prepared with a team of (4) four horses and riders, release forms, extra gloves, sticks, cell/camera phone, walkie-talkies and water. Because of the United Response Search and Rescue Team, our prayers were answered within less than (40) forty minutes of entering the field as we found our Jimmy. The compassion given by all of you before, during and after has truly been a blessing to our family. Your follow-up phone calls and visits shows sincere caring and concern. We have been blessed not only by the closure of finding our Jimmy, but by also meeting wonderful, caring and giving people such as you, Sheila, Dana, Russell and the amazing people in your team.
